

Tips to Grow Bitter Gourd in Delaware



Bitter melon, known for health properties, can be grown much like cucumbers or cantaloupes, but they are a subtropical plant and require at least three to four months of warm to hot and humid weather to mature.

- o Bitter gourd plant beds need to be kept adequately moist.
- o Aged compost can also serve wonders in feeding bitter gourd plants.
- o You should also side dress the plants using aged compost for adding requisite nutrients during the growing season.
- o You can also use comfrey tea or compost every third week for catering to the water requirements of the plant during its growing season.
