

# HIB(HAEMOPHILUS INFLUENZAE TYPE B)



- Not routinely recommended for healthy adults.

- Those adults at highest risk of serious HIB disease include people who:

- 1) have anatomic or functional asplenia,
- 2) are undergoing an elective splenectomy,

or

- 3) are recipients of hematopoietic stem cell transplant (HSCT).
