

VACCINATIONS FOR ADULTS

DO **YOU** NEED IT ?

HEPATITIS A

Maybe. You need this vaccine if you have a specific risk factor for hepatitis A* or simply want to be protected from this disease. The vaccine is usually given in 2 doses, 6–18 months apart.

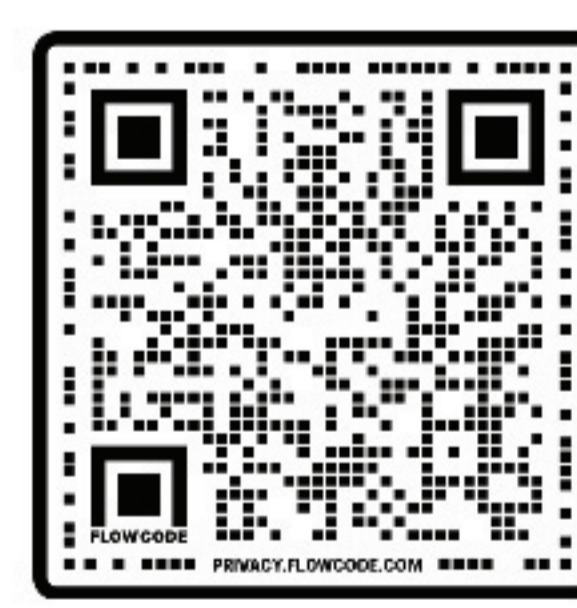
HEPATITIS B

✓ **Yes!** All adults younger than 60 are recommended to complete a 2- or 3-dose series of hepatitis B vaccine, depending on the brand. You also need this vaccine if you are 60 or older and have a specific risk factor, or you don't have a risk factor but simply want to be vaccinated.

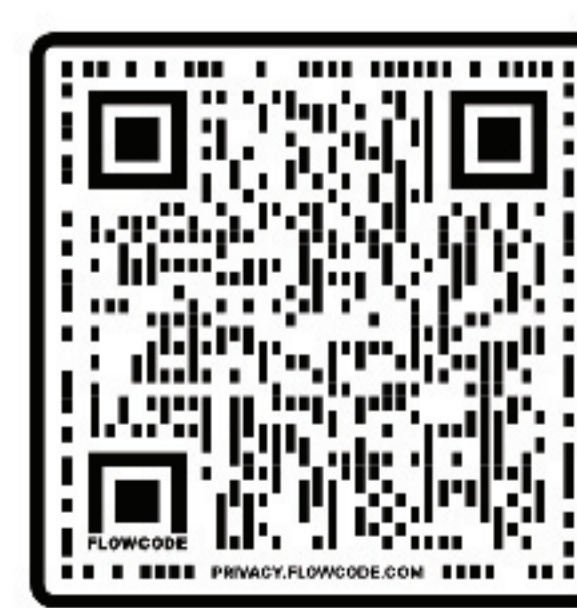
